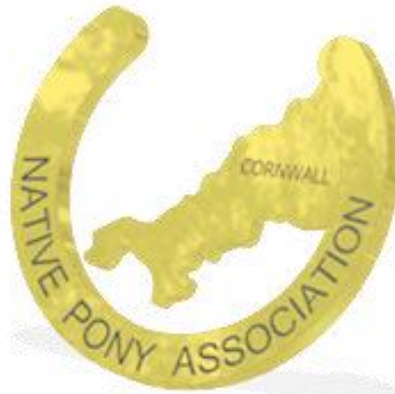

NPS Qualifiers

NPS Mountain and Moorland Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part bred are not eligible.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to both NPS Members and Non Members but only ponies owned by adult NPS members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition. The highest placed pony owned by an NPS member in each class will qualify for the Final. Where this pony has already qualified the pony standing next in line which is owned by an NPS member and has not already qualified receives the qualification. Qualification may go no lower than 3rd place. Judges and/or stewards are requested to check membership cards prior to presenting the qualifying rosettes. NPSAdult/Standard members will be required to upgrade to Adult/Showing to enter the Final.

NPS Silver Medal Championship Conditions

These Championships are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded where the Owner of the champion pony is a Member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the Rider's/Handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the Owner of the Champion pony is not a Member, or the Owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the Qualification Card goes to the Reserve Champion pony provided the Owner of that pony is a Member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the Qualification Card can be awarded to no lower than first Reserve. Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship, 4-6 AUGUST 2010

NPS Mountain & Moorland In-Hand Kilmannan Stud Silver Medal Rosette Championship.

This show is a qualifier for the South West pony Association Championship to be held on 10 11 12 SEPTEMBER 2010, at the David Broome Event Centre.

To qualify for the championships:

1. Enter one of the qualifying classes
2. Be one of the two highest placed exhibits not already qualified within the first four and receive a qualification card
3. Complete the entry form on the qualification card
4. Return the card with any membership fees, due within 14 days of this show

1. All ponies must be registered with one of the nine Native Pony Breed Societies main stud book.
2. In part – bred classes the pony must be registered in their respective part-bred registers. Where a Native Breed Society does not have a part bred register, then breeding must be given to show from which registered pony (with registered number) the part bred is descended. **REGISTRATION NUMBERS MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRIES OR ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**
3. Ponies must be shown in natural state. Optional Plaiting for part bred.
4. Ponies in all Ridden and Driving classes must be four years or over.
5. All brood mares must be four years old or over, and with foal at foot.
6. Foals must be at least three weeks old at date of show and accompany mare in the ring.
7. Foals must be shown in the correct foal section class to which they are eligible for registration.
8. Stallions in the Stallion Championship must be four years old and over.
9. Hard hats must be worn in all ridden classes to approved current BSI Standard
10. The judge's decision will be final at all times.
11. **NO NOMINATION ENTRIES.**
12. Any Person wishing to lodge a protest having reference to any persons or exhibit, shall do so in writing within 30 minutes of the completion of the class, and at the same time shall deposit a sum of £10. If the investigation by the show committee shows the protest is not sustained the deposit shall be forfeited to the funds of the show. The committee's decision will be final.
13. The committee reserves the right to refuse entry without explanation.
14. Dogs to be kept on leads at all times.
15. Exhibitors are warned to be on the ground in plenty of time as classes will follow one another without delay.
16. First and second prize winners in each class are eligible for their respective championships.
17. **Competitors are strongly advised to have 3rd party public liability insurance.**
18. All accidents must be reported to the show secretary.
19. Please take care with children, pushchairs et
20. Cups and Trophies are the property of the NPA, you are required to return them in good condition, and before the due date May 20th 2010.
21. Stallions 138cm/small breed M&M riders must be 12 years old by 1st Jan of current year. Over 138cm/large breed M&M riders must be 14 years old by 1st Jan in current year.
