NPS/FODDER SOLUTIONS BRITISH ISLES AREA IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP

Open to 1st & 2nd prizewinners from ALL In-hand classes

The Supreme and Reserve In-Hand Champion will qualify for the Championship at the Summer Championship Show. If the Supreme or Reserve Champion pony has already qualified, qualification may go to third place (but no lower than third).

NPS WWW.HORSEQUEST.CO.UK M&M RIDDEN SILVER MEDAL ROSETTE CHAMPIONSHIP

A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by the National Pony Society for the best registered pony in the Mountain & Moorland Ridden section.

To be judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the Owner of the champion pony is a Member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the Rider's/Handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the Owner of the Champion pony is not a Member, or the Owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the Qualification Card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the Owner of that pony is a Member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the Qualification Card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve. Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show 5-7th August 2009.

NPS / KAREL DOYLE AND JASEAN SPRAGGETT BRITISH ISLES AREA WORKING HUNTER PONY CHAMPIONSHIP The winning pony from each of the working hunter pony classes held at the Show is eligible to go forward to this championship.

The Supreme Champion and Reserve Supreme Champion ponies at each Area show qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship show. If the Supreme and/or Reserve Supreme has already qualified then the qualification may go to the third place, but no lower.

The owner need not be an NPS member for the pony/horse to enter this competition or to qualify for the final but will have to become a Showing member to enter the final. There are no specific registration criteria for ponies.

NPS Mountain and Moorland Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part bred are not eligible. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition.

The highest placed pony owned by an NPS member in each class will qualify for the Final. Where this pony has already qualified the pony standing next in line which is owned by an NPS member and has not already qualified receives the qualification. Qualification may go no lower than 3rd place. NPS Adult/Standard members will be required to upgrade to Adult/Showing to enter the Final.

NPS Show Pony and Show Hunter Pony Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register or Appendix, the GSB, the AHSB, the AASB or in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part-Breds are not eligible unless entered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register or Appendix. Ponies must be plaited.

Qualifying rounds are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition.

The highest placed pony owned by an NPS member in each class will qualify for the Final. Where this pony has already qualified the pony standing next in line which is owned by an NPS member, and has not already qualified, receives the qualification. Qualification may go no lower than 3rd place. NPS Adult/Standard members will be required to upgrade to Adult/Showing to enter the Final.

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship – Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rule book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show.

This class is open to registered M&M Mares and geldings, 4 years old or over registered in the main body of their respective Stud Books. Ponies not to not exceed 122cm (12h) Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. The highest placed pony not already qualified from the first 3 will qualify to compete at the Horse of the Year Show 2008. To be run under the rules of the National Pony Society. Judges may only judge one qualifying competition in the current year. Marks to be awarded 50/50.

Where more than 20 entrants are forward in each class, the class may be split. The judges should split the class according to the circumstances on the day. The first five ponies in a split class will go forward to the final

judging. the highest placed pony (not already qualified) from the first 3 in the final judging will qualify for HOYS 2008. Please note: Ponies that qualify for this Championship at HOYS 2008 must hold a valid JMB Full Height or Annual Certificate, a copy of which must be enclosed at the time of entry to HOYS. JMB certificates are NOT required to enter this qualifier. The 2 highest placed exhibits not already qualified will qualify for the Equifest M&M Lead Rein Final to be held at the East of England Showground on the 20-23 August 2009

This class is open to registered M&M Mares and geldings, 4 years old or over registered in the main body of their respective Stud Books. Ponies not to exceed 128cm (12.2h) Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. The highest placed pony not already qualified from the first 3 will qualify to compete at the Horse of the Year Show 2009. To be run under the rules of the National Pony Society. Judges may only judge one qualifying competition in the current year. Marks to be awarded 50/50. In the event of equality, the pony with the highest Show/Freedom of Action mark will be deemed the winner.

Where more than 20 entrants are forward in each class, the judges may split the class into sections according to circumstances on the day. Each section must be marked and the top five ponies with the highest marks should go forward to a final judging. The marks are not to be displayed at this point and no rosettes awarded. For the final judging the top ponies should be invited back into the ring and lined up in any order. No further show will be given. The judges should then refer to their original marks. In the case of equality, the pony with the highest Show/Freedom of Action mark will be deemed the winner. If there still be equality at this point, then the judges' decision will be final. The highest place animal (not already qualified) from the first three in the final judging will qualify for HOYS, subject to verification from the HOYS office.

Please note: Ponies that qualify for this Championship at HOYS 2009 must hold a valid JMB Full Height or Annual Certificate, a copy of which must be enclosed at the time of entry to HOYS. JMB certificates are NOT required to enter this qualifier. Where the first pony in the class has already qualified, the pony standing next in line which has not qualified will be deemed the qualifier. Qualification may go no lower than third place.
2. A pony shall not be deemed to be a Novice if by 1st January of the current year it has:-
won an open NPS Affiliated Ridden Mountain & Moorland class
won a class at an Olympia/HOYS or RIHS Qualifying round
Qualified for HOYS or RIHS
Qualified for the Novice/Intermediate Ridden Mountain & Moorland Final at Malvern
Qualified for the M&M Ridden Championship at Olympia in previous years or the current year
3. All ponies in Novice classes must be shown in one of the snaffle bridles illustrated in the NPS 2009 Showing and Competition Rules
4. Before entering open Qualifying rounds for the NPS / Bailey's Horse Feeds M&M Supreme Ridden Pony of the Year owners must be Adult/Showing members of the NPS and must show their membership card before entering the ring
5. The pony is to be owned and produced by the exhibitor, who must be a full adult NPS member and carry their current membership card in the ring.
6. The Committee reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate any Class with less than 3 entries at closing date, sub-divide any class or withdraw any prize money.
7. The Committee reserve the right to refuse entries without giving a reason
8. Any objections must be handed to the secretary in writing within 10 minutes of the class being judged, accompanied by £20.00. Deposit returnable if the objection is upheld.
9. The Committee will not be responsible for any accident to animals, persons or property.
10. The decisions of the Judges and Committee are final.
11. No entry fees will be refunded without a veterinary certificate

12. No nominations or substitutions are allowed.

13. It is the responsibility of exhibitors to enter their ponies in the correct class or classes.

14. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by full fees.

15. If a pony exceeds the height limit on the day it may be transferred to another class at the discretion of the Committee.

16. All exhibitors must be ready for their class to be judged and no class will be held up for entries competing in another ring.

17. No Ponies may be plaited in M&M Classes.

18. Numbers to be collected on the showground. Entries only acknowledged on receipt of an S.A.E.

19. Correctly secured British Standard skull caps/riding hats BS 4472/6473 (BS)EN1384 or PAS 015 must be worn at all times when mounted.

20. No loose dogs allowed on the showground.

21. In all ridden classes the wearing of SPURS is forbidden.

22. Show canes/whips must not exceed 30".

23. All ponies entered in M&M classes must be registered in their respective Stud Books and shown under their Breed Society Showing Rules.

24. Registration numbers must be stated on the entry form and with entries on the day.

25. All Riding Pony Stallions and colts, two years old or over, must be in possession of a current Ministry of Agriculture, National Pony Society or appropriate Breed Society Stallion Licence. For M&M classes this rule remains at two years old except Highland, Dartmoor, Welsh, Exmoor and Dales ponies this rule is extended to three years old or over and for Shetlands the rule is four years old or over.

26. Handlers of stallions or colts must have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January of the current year. In Mountain and Moorland classes riders of stallions must have attained their 11th birthday before 1st January of the current year when riding small breeds (Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh A & B). For large breeds (Highland, Fell, Dales, Connemara, New Forest, Welsh C & D) riders must have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January. In Show Pony/Show Hunter Pony classes riders must have attained their 11th birthday before 1st January in the current year when riding Stallions not exceeding 128 cm (12.2hh) and their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year when riding stallions exceeding 128 cm (12.2 hh).

27. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition. The highest placed pony owned by an NPS member in each class will qualify for the Final. Where this pony has already qualified the pony standing next in line which is owned by an NPS member and has not already qualified receives the qualification. Qualification may go no lower than 3rd place. Judges and/or stewards are requested to check membership cards prior to presenting the qualifying rosettes. NPS Adult/Standard members will be required to upgrade to Adult/Showing to enter the Final.

28. At Breed Show qualifying rounds owners need not be members of the NPS in order to qualify. Should such an Exhibitor qualify the owners must become an adult/showing member of the NPS and the pony entered in the Competition final within 14 days for the qualification to be valid. This show is running Exmoor Breed qualifiers in conjunction with ordinary NPS qualifying rounds.
